



Differences in the sexes


- Morphology

- Consequences are generally observed as **male competition** and **female choice**.









Sexual selection theory in a nutshell:


- Males of most species invest less than
- females in offspring.
- As a result, reproductive success of males is
- limited by the number of mates.
- For females, reproductive success is
- influenced more by mate quality.
- Thus, males should compete with each other
- for mates, and not be very choosy.
- However, females should be selective in choosing a mate.
