

Botany summer help needed

Would you please distribute the message below so students can see.

The Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest (in central and north central Washington) will need summer help this year to do vegetation sampling along old transects. This work will involve stretching a tape and sampling the vegetation along the tape with both a Parker loop and a quadrat frame to collect information on species, frequency, and cover. Good plant identification skills are needed for this work. This work will be in the field and may occur on steep and rugged terrain, and in inclement weather. Biting and stinging insects may be encountered. Pay will depend on qualifications. If a student is returning to classes in the fall they can submit an application to me and I will give it to personnel. Submit an application with a copy of transcript and proof of returning to class in the fall, e.g., a letter from an advisor, list of classes signed up for in the fall, or other proof of return to class. If a nonstudent wants to apply or a student is graduating and not returning to class then an application will need to be made to the Forest Service through Boise.
